Three Events Planned to Benefit Muscular Dystrophy Association

Green Bay – January 31, 2008 - The Green Bay Harley Owner's Group will sponsor three fund-raising activities for 2008. All events benefit the Muscular Dystrophy Association. In addition to the annual Packerland Ride for MDA on June 7, everyone is invited to the Fest-of-Ale on March 21 at the Stadium View Bar and Grill on Holmgren Way. In addition, the Green Bay HOG Chapter is raffling off a 2008 Harley-Davidson Heritage Softail motorcycle.

Fest-of-Ale – a beer-tasting event. Friday, March 21. Beer tasting of over 70 specialty beers begins at **6 p.m. at Stadium View Bar and Grill** on Holmgren Way. There will also be free food, raffles, and an auction featuring Packer Memorabilia. The first 250 people through the door will receive a free Fest-of-Ale tasting mug. Music provided by Chris Carey. Several new 2008 Harley-Davidson motorcycles will be displayed. **Tickets are \$20 in advance, \$25 at the door**, and can be purchased at McCoy's Harley Davidson, Stadium View Bar and Grill, Green Bay, and Ticket Star.

The 15th Annual Packerland Ride -- Saturday, June 7. The ride departs McCoy's Harley-Davidson at 11 a.m. and heads to Gillett, where festivities continue at Zippel Park, **from noon to 2 p.m.** The winner of the 2008 Harley-Davidson motorcycle will be drawn at 2:00 p.m. The party continues at **3 p.m. back** in the Green Bay area **at Idlewild Park in Suamico**, where riders and guests will enjoy free food, raffles, auctions, and their favorite music. A \$20 donation per person, or more in pledges, is asked of each participant. The event is open to all makes and models of motorcycles and riders.

Win a Harley!! – A 2008 Harley-Davidson Heritage Softail Motorcycle Raffle. Tickets cost \$20. Only 1700 tickets will be sold. **Raffle winner will be drawn during the Packerland Ride event on June 7 at 2 p.m. at Zippel Park in Gillett.** The motorcycle can be seen on display from now until the drawing at various participating local businesses and events.
